Groundbreaking for P&S Machining and Fabrication/Aviation Business Center

The Alamance County Area Chamber of Commerce hosted a groundbreaking event today for P & S Machining and Fabrication Company. The company was created in 1965 and operates on Gant Road in Graham. The company has grown in their existing facility from 1,800 square feet to 55,000 square feet. In 1997, Mike and Tommy Scoggins purchased the business from their father, after managing the company for several years. They are committed to continue operating in Alamance County and today, they break ground on a new building for their operation and additional office space to lease to other users.

Today, P&S Machining and Fabrication takes raw metal and machines and fabricates products to a customer's specification often detailed by a blueprint. The typical products include; shafts, heat sinks, mounting plates, brackets, electrical enclosures, meter housings and work fixtures are just some of the products produced. Materials used in the products include: steel, stainless steel, aluminum, brass, copper, bronze, and plastics.

The company was designed to serve local companies and now serves companies throughout the US as well as Puerto Rico and Mexico. Recently, the Scoggins' determined a need for a more modern and efficient facility. That brings us to today's celebration.

The 10-acre tract, located on Tucker Street Extension, will be known as Aviation Business Center. On the site, a 50,000 square foot building for manufacturing space, expandable to 100,000 square feet will be constructed. In addition, there will be 15,000 square feet of office space and 12,500 will be available for lease. The company currently employs approximately 30 people and intends to grow the workforce over the next 3 years. Their investment in this project will reach the \$3 million level at completion. Construction schedule will begin immediately.
