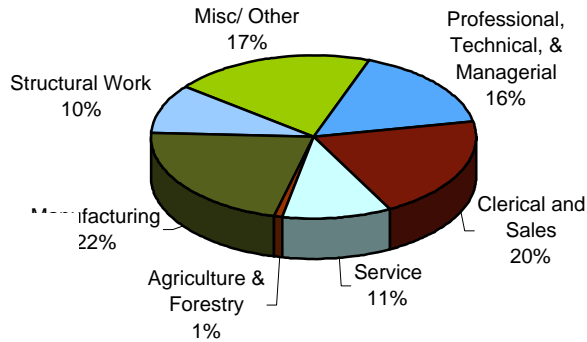

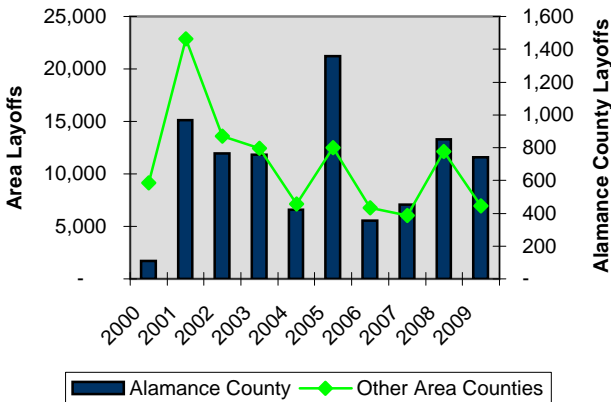
## Alamance County Available Job Applicants By Job Category
