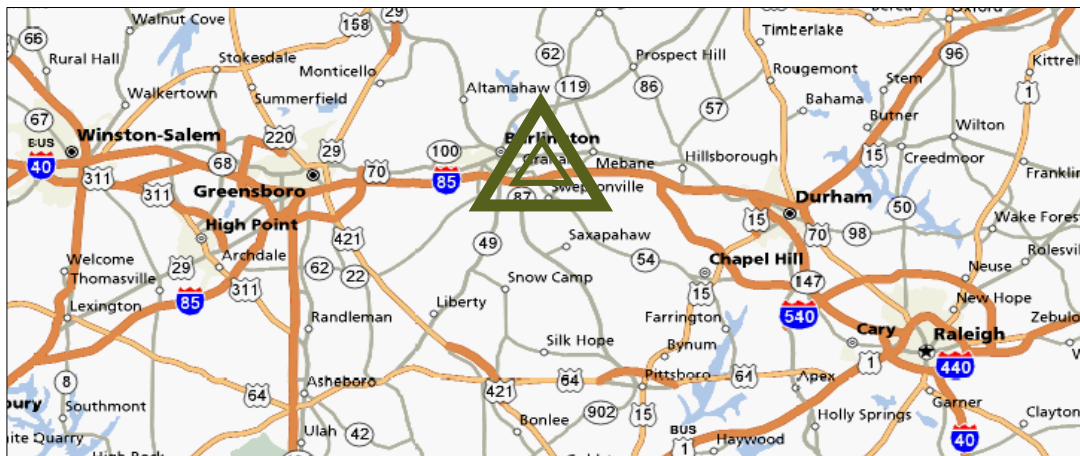


# Transportation Network

## Major Highways



Alamance County has two major Interstates 85 (north/south) and 40 (east/west) which link the Research Triangle Region and the Piedmont Triad Region. Interstates 95 and 77 are approximately 90 miles away. Alamance County has over 23 trucking companies which employ close to 500 employees.

## Ports

Three modern, deep-water ports provide shipping service to Alamance County along with two inland ports. Inland ports reduce total shipment costs by consolidating individual truckloads. These ports are located in neighboring Greensboro as well as Charlotte. Facilities have warehousing capabilities and rail access.
